C. **PROPOSED REVISED CURRICULUM FOR NORTH ALABAMA WELLNESS SCHOOL OF MASSAGE**

Ms. Smith reported that the Alabama Massage Therapy Licensing Board Administrative Code 532-X-5-.02, the Board must consider continued approval of a massage therapy school after a change of ownership, curriculum, or staff.

On November 4, 2024, the Executive Director of Education of North Alabama Wellness School of Massage submitted a revised curriculum and supporting documentation. On November 8, 2024, ABN consultant contacted the Executive Director of Education requesting clarification to the submitted documentation. The documents were revised and submitted the same day.

Board consultants have reviewed all documentation submitted by North Alabama Wellness School of Massage and prepared a Curriculum Verification Form. Based on review of the submitted materials compared to the requirements in the AMTLB rules, the Board consultants have

determined that North Alabama Wellness School of Massage meets all of the regulatory criteria.

On November 15, 2024, Ms. Armstrong moved that the Board approve North Alabama Wellness School of Massage. Ms. Lofton seconded. Motion carried without objection.

D. APPROVAL FOR MS. SANDY BROOKS LMT, OWNER, AND OPERATOR OF NEW MASSAGE THERAPY SCHOOL APPROVAL DOTHAN WELLNESS ACADEMY

Ms. Smith reported that the Alabama Massage Therapy Licensing Board Administrative Code 532-X-5-.06. to be approved by the Board a massage therapy school located in the State of Alabama must apply directly to the Board and submit a registration fee. The Board then reviews the completed application and required supporting documentation for completeness and compliance with rules and regulations and provides guidance regarding forward progress of the plan. If all standards for approval are met, then the Board may approve the new school.

On September 9, 2024, the owner and operator of Spa Therapy submitted a letter of intent, and an application of supporting documentation to establish a new Massage Therapy School. On September 30, 2024, Alabama Board of Nursing (ABN) consultant contacted the owner and operator of Spa Therapy inquiring about application and fee. On October 18, 2024, Alabama Board of Nursing (ABN) consultants contacted the owner and operator of Spa Therapy for clarification of submitted documentation and requested additional information. The documents were resubmitted on October 21, 2024.

On November 7, 2024, the owner and operator of Spa Therapy submitted additional required documents and the application fee. On November 8, 2024, Alabama Board of Nursing (ABN) consultants contacted the owner and operator of Spa Therapy regarding revisions to submitted documentation, the documents were submitted the same day. The additional revisions were submitted November 12, and 13, 2024 to Alabama Board of Nursing (ABN).

According to the submitted applications, the owner and operator of Spa Therapy anticipates admitting students to the Dothan Wellness Academy in the January of 2025.

Board consultants have reviewed all documentation submitted by Ms. Sandy Brooks, LMT, owner and operator of Spa Therapy and prepared an evaluation of the proposal for establishing a massage therapy school. Based on a review of the submitted materials compared to the requirements in the Alabama Massage Therapy Licensing Board (AMTLB)

rules, the Board staff has determined that the owner and operator of Spa Therapy meets all the regulatory criteria with the exception of "...registered as Massage Therapy Instructor.

On November 15, 2024, Ms. Armstrong moved that the Board approve Ms. Sandy Brooks, LMT and owner and operator of Spa Therapy application for a new massage therapy school. Ms. Lofton seconded. Motion carried without objection.

VIII. POLICY

A. REVISIONS TO ALABAMA MASSAGE THERAPY LICENSING BOARD ADMINISTRATIVE CODE 532-X-1-.15 AND 532-X-4-.03.

Mr. Ingels reported that the Board staff proposes revisions of the subject sections of the Alabama Massage Therapy Licensing Board Administrative Code. The revisions seek to ease the licensing process by allowing the Executive Officer to grant extension of renewal under extraordinary circumstances, such as the recent transition of the Alabama Massage Therapy Licensing Board to management of the Alabama Board of Nursing, and by removing the requirement that new establishment applicants appear before the Board to present their applications.

On November 15, 2024, Ms. Buford moved that the Board approve as proposal and emergency rules, revisions to Alabama Massage Therapy Licensing Board (AMTLB) Administrative Code 532-X-1-.15 and 532-X-4-.03. Mr. Sapalaran seconded. Motion carried without objection.
